## first announcement 5th Amsterdam Menopause Symposium

19 - 21 June 2007

Amsterdam, The Netherlands



For many, the Amsterdam Menopause Symposium needs no introduction.

From its start in 1998 as a small symposium for dedicated experts to discuss menopause and the risks and benefits of hormone replacement therapy, the MS has evolved into an well-known forum where doctors can meet with international experts to discuss their problems in daily practice, and to critically review the newest scientific developments.

Today, the Amsterdam Menopause Symposium sees the meeting of around 1,000 experts and professionals with a well-established programme: plenary sessions in the morning - with reviews and debates by leading experts - followed in the afternoon by smaller parallel sessions with keynote speakers, intimate meet-the-professor meetings, poster sessions for all participants and satellite symposia and workshops. Sponsored symposia are held during the lunch hours.

The discussion will focus on optimal management of the menopause, as adapted to individual women's needs; critical assessment of individual risks and benefits of HT and its alternatives; female sexuality and aging; quality of life in the menopause, and life style and healthy aging. At this year's symposium, special attention will be granted to premature menopause in general, and more specifically to the problems and options in the instance of surgically or medically induced premature menopause.

And like the first four highly successful meetings, this fifth AMS will aim to translate "progress in menopause science" into "down-to-earth menopause clinical practice".

Once again, scientists and doctors from all over the world will be coming to Amsterdam to meet and discuss. We cordially invite you to join them.
